- ◉ Our Erasmus + project „Theater in the fight against virtual threats” was aimed to people with intellectual disabilities. It was a response to the observed phenomenon of new threats arising from the use of the Internet, mobile phones and being in a virtual space by people with disabilities. The risks of staying in the virtual world (dissemination of harmful content, dangerous online contacts, cyberbullying, cybercrime and addiction)

- ◉ Our last KA 220 ADU Erasmus + project „Online Art Therapy”
- ◉ The project was a continuation of activities for people with intellectual disabilities. The aim of the project was to improve the situation of people with intellectual disabilities after the covid19 pandemic by creating tools for remote art therapy.
- ◉ The result of the activities are 10 instructional videos for conducting remote art therapy among people with intellectual disabilities.
